The RCIA Process

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the Church's process for initiating new members or completing an initiation that has been interrupted. Non-Catholics are invited to participate and explore more deeply what Catholics believe about Jesus Christ and how we come to better know, love and serve Him.

Who is RCIA for?

- ❖ Those who desire Baptism.
- ❖ Baptized Christians (non-Catholic) who want to learn more about what Catholics believe and who may be considering becoming Catholic.
- ❖ Those who were baptized Catholic but have not received further Catholic instruction or sacraments.

The Catholic Church warmly welcomes all those who want to know Christ and learn about the Church. We strive to provide an appropriate spiritual formation according to each person's needs.

We want you to know how much God loves you and cares for you. Please stop in to inquire about the Catholic Church and our beliefs. We welcome you to share the Word of God with us in our celebration of the Sunday or Weekday Mass.
