INSTRUCTIONS FOR NEW HIRE ONBOARDING PROCESS

THIS PAGE IS TO BE GIVEN TO YOUR NEW EMPLOYEE



Once your school/parish has turned in your new hire information to the Diocesan Payroll Office, you will be sent an email to complete all of your personnel information online and register for a Diocesan Paycor account. This account is how you will electronically receive your semi-monthly paystubs. Additionally, you will be able to access electronic versions of your Forms W2 and 1095C at year-end. It is important that you follow all instructions below in order to properly be setup in our payroll system.

**PLEASE NOTE: 1) You will not be able to receive your first paycheck until this process is entirely completed;
2) You must register from a PC – DO NOT ATTEMPT TO COMPLETE THIS PROCESS ON A PHONE OR TABLET.**

1. Once your parish/school turns in the information to put you on the payroll system, you will receive an email from noreply@Notifications.Paycor.com. If you do not receive the email in a timely manner, please check your spam/junk folder or contact your parish/school to be sure that your information has been given to the Diocesan Payroll Office.
2. The email you receive will have instructions on how to register with Paycor and will contain a link to do so. Simply click that link to start completing your payroll information.
3. You will be prompted to enter your last name and email address. The required access code will populate automatically. Click “NEXT”.
4. You will see the “SIGN IN CREDENTIALS” screen. Please enter a Username, Password and check both acknowledgement boxes (you will need to scroll through the entire “License Agreement” to check the second box. Then click “NEXT”.

IMPORTANT: If you have a Paycor account from a different employer, **DO NOT** login with those credentials under “Sign In”. You must create a new username/password on this screen to be active in the Diocesan payroll system.

5. You will then see the “SECURITY SETUP” screen. You have three choices for security prompts: Authenticator, Phone (texts) or Email (default). Once you’ve made your selection(s), click “Save & Continue”.
6. You will then be prompted to create and enter answers for four security questions.
7. You will then see the main Paycor Login screen. Log in with the credentials you created above.
8. You will then see the “Onboarding” screen. The left side of the screen will show the various sections that must be completed. Once you complete a section, you will see a green checkmark to indicate that section has been complete. You must complete the sections in order, and you cannot move ahead until the current section has been properly completed.
9. Please carefully read and follow the instructions on each page as presented. Again, you cannot move ahead until the current page has been fully and accurately completed. The various sections, and some commentary on each one are as follows:



- a. *Welcome* – This screen gives you some general information (and a link to more specific information) about the Diocese and our Benefits programs. You can also view a video welcome message from Bishop Iffert. Once you’ve read the message (and viewed the link at the bottom of the screen), click the “Start Onboarding Now” button.
- b. *Personal* – This screen collects various personal information for your payroll profile. Information that has already been communicated to the Diocesan Payroll Office will already show up on this screen. Information with an “*” by the field name is required information. Once completed, click “Save & Continue”
- c. *Contact* – This screen collects contact information for you. Once completed, click “Save & Continue”
- d. *Form I-9 Verification* – This screen collects information that prepares the employee section of the IRS Form I-9 that all employers are required to collect. Simply answer the questions and click “Save & Continue”. You will then be presented with a screenshot of the employee section of the Form I-9 which you must electronically sign by entering the last four digits of your SSN and name in the two fields at the bottom of the screen. Click “Sign & Continue”. You are then reminded of the documentation that you should have already provided to your local parish/school. Click “Save & Continue”
- e. *Direct Deposit* – We require all employees to use direct deposit. To complete this section, it will be helpful for you to have a blank check (**NOT** deposit ticket) available from the account to which your pay checks will be deposited. Enter the requested information from the check and click “Save & Continue”.
- f. *Tax Setup* – This section will allow you to complete the appropriate US and state tax withholding forms. Click “Launch Tax Setup” to begin. Answer the questions as they are presented and the system will guide you through the preparation of the proper forms. Once the answers have been provided for each form, you will be presented with a copy of that form. (Note that if it is too small to be legible, simply increase the “zoom” setting on your internet browser. Please review it carefully, click the acknowledgement box at the bottom of the form and then click “Submit Form”. You will then go back to the “Onboarding” tool and (if you’re satisfied with your tax withholding elections), click “Save & Continue”.
- g. *Documents* – This section contains documents that have already been (or need to be) filled out by you. Depending on your employment status, you may have several forms to complete.
 - i. Note that before you can complete any of these forms, you must click the “Setup Electronic Signature” button.
 - ii. Once that is done, click the “View Now” of the document you need to complete, and enter the appropriate information in all required fields of that document. Note that for the “Diocese of Covington Benefits Package” document, there are no fields to complete, you must simply electronically sign that you have seen this document.
 - iii. At the end of each form, simply click anywhere in the “Electronic Signature*” box to enter your signature, and click “Sign and Continue”.
 - iv. Once all documents have been properly completed, click the “Save & Continue” button.
- h. *Review* – This screen allows you to review (and edit if necessary) the basic information you are about to submit. Once you are satisfied that all of the information is correct, click the “Submit Onboarding” button. **NOTE: UNTIL YOU CLICK THIS “SUBMIT” BUTTON AND SEE GREEN CHECK MARKS BESIDE EACH SECTION ON THE LEFT SIDE OF THE SCREEN, YOUR INFORMATION HAS NOT BEEN SUBMITTED.**

10. Once you have submitted your information, you are presented with a link that will allow you to download your “Employment Documents Package”. Once downloaded, you can save/print to your local computer/printer.
