



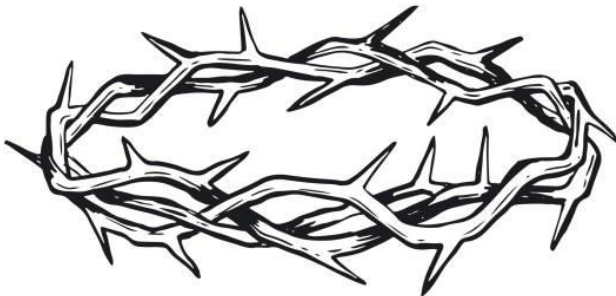
RESPONSORY
