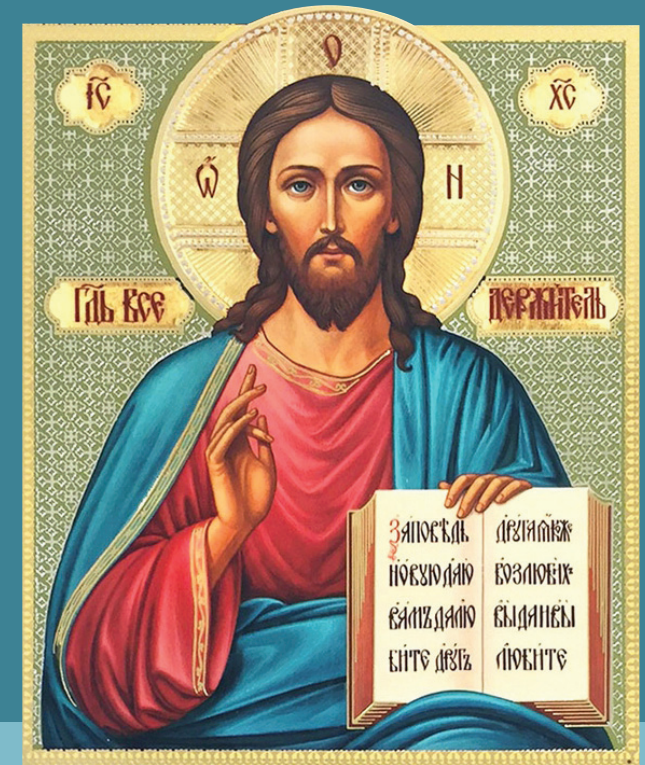
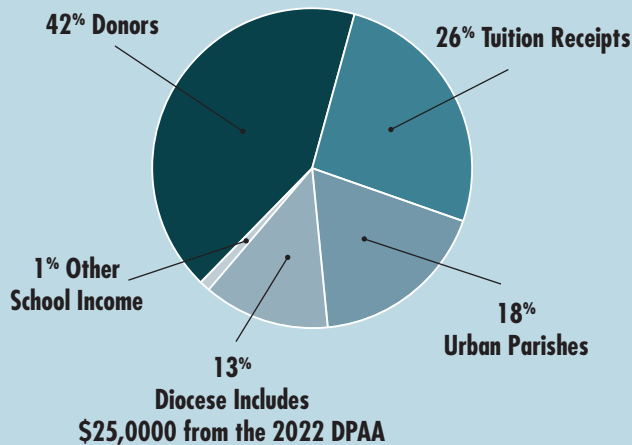
Enrollment

- Students - 513

CEP Schools have such a high poverty that 100% of students receive the federal free-lunch program.

Financial Operations (\$3,701,000)

- Tuition charged was based on documented family income/ability to pay.

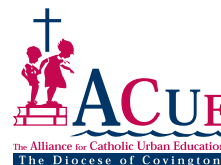

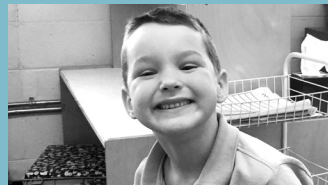

In addition, ACUE students and staff remember the ACUE family of donors daily in prayer and weekly at all-school liturgies.



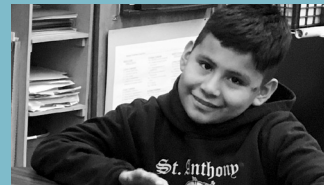

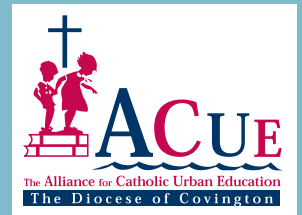
