

Diocese of Covington Pro-Life Office High School Pro-Life Scholarship

A \$500 scholarship to be awarded to a current high school student to be used to assist in payment of his/her college or Catholic high school tuition.

General Criteria:

- Applicant will have demonstrated a commitment to promoting the dignity of all human life.
- Applicant will have participated in multiple pro-life activities.
- Applicant will submit one letter of recommendation verifying involvement in prolife activities

Conditions of Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a current student who attends a high school within the geographical boundaries of the Diocese of Covington. (If the applicant is in a Homeschool program, he or she must reside within the geographical boundaries of the Diocese of Covington.)
- Applicant must submit a written application. Application must be received by the Diocesan Pro-Life office on or before <u>April 12, 2024</u>
- Applicant must submit an essay (500 words or less), video (8 minutes or less), <u>or</u> other creative work demonstrating his/her passion for the sanctity of human life. Submitted items become the property of the Diocese of Covington.
- Applicant may not be a past recipient of this scholarship.

Method of Selection:

- The Scholarship Selection Committee is composed of members of the Diocesan Pro-Life Advisory Board.
- The scholarship recipient will be announced by May 5 and personally notified.
- All applicants will receive a letter of recognition.
