- ☐ A **certificate of baptism** for the Catholic parties involved. The certificate must be issued from the parish of baptism within the last six months. It must include all sacramental notations and the parish seal. If a party was baptized in a non-Catholic church or ecclesial community and was later received into the Catholic Church, a **certificate of reception** from the parish of reception is required. Copies are not acceptable.
- ☐ A **certified copy** (i.e., stamped and dated by the county clerk) **of the marriage license** issued by the office of the county clerk.
- ☐ A **certified copy of the civil divorce decree** issued by the office of the county clerk.

PETITION

I, the undersigned petitioner, do hereby petition the Tribunal of the Diocese of Covington for a declaration of nullity regarding my marriage, the details of which are provided in the accompanying paperwork.

The Tribunal of the Diocese of Covington is competent to adjudicate this case because:

I attempted marriage with the respondent as detailed in the accompanying paperwork. The respondent and I are civilly divorced and there is no possibility of restoring conjugal life. It is my contention that the cleric who assisted at the wedding was not properly delegated, resulting in a defect of canonical form. Therefore, I argue that my marriage was invalid from the beginning, according to canon 1108 §1. In support of my argument, I submit the accompanying information and documentation and ask the Tribunal to examine the relevant diocesan and parochial files pertaining to my attempted marriage.

Because the defect of form ought to be established with certainty by documentation, I ask that the judicial vicar issue a sentence declaring the nullity of my marriage according to the documentary process provided in canon 1686.
