FACTS AND INFORMATION

CATHOLIC RELIEF SERVICES

This appeal supports relief and resettlement services to victims of natural disasters, war, religious and ethnic persecution. It also supports agencies that build the international social ministry of the Catholic Church through advocacy on behalf of the powerless and impoverished.

CHURCH IN CENTRAL AND EASTERN EUROPE

This Collection channels aid through the bishops' conferences of Central and Eastern Europe to meet the needs of rebuilding the Church in formerly Communist nations - training seminarians and lay leaders, reaching out to young people, revitalize Catholic charities and renew programs of catechesis and evangelization.

CHURCH IN LATIN AMERICA

Support for various pastoral projects throughout Latin America and the Caribbean are made possible through the Collection for the Church in Latin America. Projects are at the continental, regional, diocesan and local levels and include the work of evangelization, formation of laity, religious and seminarians, as well as youth ministry and catechesis.

HOLY LAND COLLECTION

These monies are collected for the preservation of holy places in the land where Jesus walked and taught, but above all for those pastoral, charitable, educational and social works which the Church supports in the Holy Land. The Catholic Church in the Holy Land spreads and promotes love, co-operation and peace among all inhabitants.

PONTIFICAL MISSION SOCIETIES

The Pontifical Mission Societies are a worldwide network at the service of the Pope that supports the missions and the Young Churches with prayer and charity. These include the Society for the Propagation of the Faith, the Society of St. Peter the Apostle, the Missionary Childhood Association and the Missionary Union of Priests and Religious. Throughout the world, The Pontifical Mission Societies support the proclamation of the Gospel, the building of churches, together with the work and witness of mission priests, religious Sisters and Brothers, and lay pastoral leaders. These missionaries reveal the compassionate heart of Jesus through their work that often entails providing not only spiritual support but also food, education, and medical care to the most vulnerable communities in the Pope's missions.
