Kentucky Horse Racing & Gaming (KHRG), an independent, de jure municipal corporation and political subdivision of the Commonwealth of Kentucky regulates all charitable gaming in the state. All parishes, schools and institutions are required to know, understand, and follow all applicable state laws and regulations as well as all Diocesan policies associated with charitable gaming.
